Dear Ms. Stilwell,

We write on behalf of our client [REDACTED], in response to your letter dated October 29, 2018, which we received on October 31. We submitted our client's claim for false arrest and false imprisonment on June 20, 2018, in a six-page letter with attachments. The letter and attachments detailed the competent evidence supporting his claim and the particular type of damages for unlawful restraint he is claiming. The claim letter makes clear that the documents sought by your October 29 letter – a physician report, medical bills, and property damage repair bills or estimates – are irrelevant to this particular claim that Border Patrol agents unlawfully restrained and detained Mr. [REDACTED] for hours, without any valid grounds for interfering with his liberty and freedom of movement, and did so based on legally prohibited grounds. The irrelevant documents your October 29 letter requested therefore will not be submitted. We await the prompt conclusion of your review of our client's claim.
