**ORDER SETTING PRODUCTION DEADLINE, STATUS CONFERENCE,  
SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE, AND BRIEFING SCHEDULE**

THIS MATTER came before the Court at a Rule 16 Initial Scheduling Conference held on August 13, 2020. After conferring with counsel, the Court agreed to set pretrial deadlines and conferences as provided herein.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant shall produce all responsive documents and, if applicable, a *Vaughn* index no later than **Friday, November 6, 2020**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court will hold a telephonic status conference on **Monday, November 16, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.** Counsel are to call Judge Khalsa's AT&T conference line at (877) 848-7030 and enter Code: 7324132 to connect to the proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court will conduct a settlement conference via Zoom videoconferencing on **Monday, November 23, 2020 beginning at 1:30 p.m.** In preparation for settlement discussions, Plaintiff must submit a demand letter to Defendant no later than **Tuesday, November 10, 2020**. Defendant must submit a counteroffer letter to Plaintiff no later than **Wednesday, November 18, 2020**. The parties

shall each submit a concise confidential position statement to the Court **by 12:00 p.m. on Friday, November 20, 2020**. The parties' confidential position statements must include, *inter alia*, the names, email addresses, and phone numbers of the individuals who will be attending the conference and in what capacity. Position statements must be submitted to the Court either by facsimile at **(505) 348-2345** or by e-mail to the Court's proposed text box at [khalsaproposedtext@nmd.uscourts.gov](mailto:khalsaproposedtext@nmd.uscourts.gov).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if settlement is not achieved prior to or at the settlement conference, the parties must file dispositive motions in accordance with the following schedule: Plaintiff's opening brief due by **Friday, December 4, 2020**; Defendant's response and cross-motion due by **Monday, January 4, 2021**; Plaintiff's reply on its opening motion and response to Defendant's cross-motion due by **Friday, January 29, 2021**; Defendant's reply on its cross-motion due by **February 12, 2021**.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
