United States, No. EP-22-CV-00295-FM (W.D. Tex. Mar. 23, 2023) 15 (Ex. A) and C.D.A. v. United States, No. 5:21-cv-00469-EGS (Mar. 28, 2023) (Ex. B), that 16 address the arguments at issue in Defendant's motion to dismiss. 17 In D.A., the court denied the government's motion to dismiss based on the discretionary 18 function exception because of the alleged constitutional violations committed by Defendant's 19 employees. Ex. A at 13–21. The Texas court in this case also concluded that the plaintiffs had 20 stated an abuse of process claim under Texas law. *Id.* at 36–37. 21 In C.D.A., the Court similarly denied the government's motion to dismiss. That motion 22 was based Defendant's discretionary function arguments, as well as based on their arguments 23 regarding the due care exception and private analogues under state law. Ex.
